A BILL

To require the Energy Information Administration to submit to Congress and make publicly available an annual report on Federal agency policies and regulations and Executive orders that have increased or may increase energy prices in the United States, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Give Americans Sta-
5 bility at Pumps as Rising Inflation Causes Emergencies
6 Act” or the “GAS PRICE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON POLICIES, REGULATIONS, AND EXECU-**
2 **TIVE ORDERS AFFECTING ENERGY PRICES.**

3 Not later than 60 days after the date of enactment
4 of this Act, and every year thereafter, the Energy Infor-
5 mation Administration shall submit to Congress and make
6 publicly available a report detailing each Federal agency
7 policy or regulation and each Executive order with an ef-
8 fective date of January 20, 2021, or later that the Energy
9 Information Administration determines has increased or
10 may increase energy prices in the United States.
