A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend certain increases in payments for physicians' services under the Medicare program through 2022.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supporting Medicare
5 Providers Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENDING CERTAIN INCREASES IN PAYMENTS**
 2 **FOR PHYSICIANS' SERVICES UNDER THE**
 3 **MEDICARE PROGRAM THROUGH 2022.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1848(t) of the Social Se-
 5 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–4(t)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1)—

7 (A) by striking “during 2021” and insert-
 8 ing “during 2021 or 2022”; and

9 (B) by striking “January 1, 2022” and in-
 10 serting “January 1, 2023”; and

11 (2) in paragraph (2)(C)—

12 (A) in the header, by striking “2021” and
 13 inserting “2021 AND 2022”; and

14 (B) by striking “after 2021” and inserting
 15 “after 2022”.

16 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
 17 1848(c)(2)(B)(iv)(V) of the Social Security Act (42
 18 U.S.C. 1395w–4(c)(2)(B)(iv)(V)) is amended by striking
 19 “2021” and inserting “2021 or 2022”.

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
