A BILL

For the relief of Michael Janssen and Steven Passantino.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER RETIREMENT**
4 **BENEFITS FOR MICHAEL JANSSEN AND STE-**
5 **VEN PASSANTINO.**

6 (a) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “law en-
7 forcement officer” has the meaning given the term in sec-
8 tion 8401 of title 5, United States Code.

9 (b) DEEMING OF SERVICE.—Notwithstanding any
10 other provision of law, and subject to subsection (c), Mi-
11 chael Janssen and Steven Passantino shall, during any pe-
12 riod in which the applicable individual is employed as a

1 series 1895 officer of the U.S. Customs and Border Pro-
2 tection before, on, or after the date of enactment of this
3 Act, be deemed to be performing service as a law enforce-
4 ment officer under chapter 84 of title 5, United States
5 Code, and shall be subject to the terms and conditions ap-
6 plicable to a law enforcement officer under that chapter.

7 (c) CREDITABLE SERVICE; DEPOSIT.—Any creditable
8 service performed before the date of enactment of this Act
9 by Michael Janssen or Steven Passantino under chapter
10 84 of title 5, United States Code, as a series 1895 officer
11 of the U.S. Customs and Border Protection shall be
12 deemed to be service as a law enforcement officer only if
13 the applicable individual meets the deposit requirements
14 of section 8411(f) of title 5, United States Code, with re-
15 spect to that service.

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
