Mr. CRUZ (for himself, Mr. BARRASSO, Mr. HAGERTY, Mr. RUBIO, Mr. MARSHALL, Mr. TILLIS, Mr. INHOFE, Mr. SASSE, and Mr. COTTON) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To require the imposition of sanctions with respect to Ansarallah and its officials, agents, or affiliates for acts of international terrorism.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS WITH RESPECT TO**
4 **ANSARALLAH.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act, the President shall—

7 (1) designate Ansarallah as a foreign terrorist
8 organization pursuant to section 219 of the Immi-
9 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189); and

1 (2) impose, with respect to Ansarallah and any
 2 foreign person the President determines is an offi-
 3 cial, agent, or affiliate of Ansarallah, the sanctions
 4 applicable with respect to a foreign person pursuant
 5 to Executive Order 13224 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; re-
 6 lating to blocking property and prohibiting trans-
 7 actions with persons who commit, threaten to com-
 8 mit, or support terrorism).

9 (b) DETERMINATION REQUIRED.—Not later than 30
 10 days after the President makes the designation required
 11 by paragraph (1) of subsection (a) and imposes the sanc-
 12 tions required by paragraph (2) of that subsection, the
 13 President shall submit to the Committee on Foreign Rela-
 14 tions of the Senate and the Committee on Foreign Affairs
 15 of the House of Representatives a determination regarding
 16 whether the following foreign persons are officials, agents,
 17 or affiliates of Ansarallah:

18 (1) Abdul Malik al-Houthi.

19 (2) Abd al-Khaliq Badr al-Din al-Houthi.

20 (3) Abdullah Yahya al-Hakim.

21 (c) ANSARALLAH DEFINED.—In this section, the
 22 term “Ansarallah” means the movement known as
 23 Ansarallah, the Houthi movement, or any other alias.

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
