A BILL

To amend the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 to clarify the scope of the authority for emergency temporary standards, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “OSHA ETS Clarifica-
5 tion Act of 2022”.

6 **SEC. 2. OSHA EMERGENCY TEMPORARY STANDARD.**

7 Section 6(c) of the Occupational Safety and Health
8 Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 655(c)) is amended—

- 1 (1) by striking “and (B)” and inserting “(B)
2 the exposure to the substances, agents, or new haz-
3 ards arises exclusively from within the workplace to
4 be covered by the emergency temporary standard, or
5 is unique and specific to the workplace to be covered
6 by the emergency temporary standard, and (C)”;
7 and
8 (2) by inserting “within the workplace” after
9 “such danger”.

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
