Mr. SCHATZ introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

Making appropriations to provide emergency assistance for the Community Development Fund for disaster response and recovery for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 The following sums are appropriated, out of any
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, and for other pur-
6 poses, namely:

1 DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN
2 DEVELOPMENT

3 COMMUNITY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

4 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND

5 For an additional amount for “Community Develop-
6 ment Fund”, \$2,000,000,000, to remain available until
7 expended, which shall be allocated and used under the
8 same authority and conditions as the additional appropria-
9 tions for fiscal year 2022 for “Department of Housing and
10 Urban Development—Community Planning and Develop-
11 ment—Community Development Fund” in title VIII of di-
12 vision B of the Extending Government Funding and Deliv-
13 ering Emergency Assistance Act (Public Law 117–43):
14 *Provided*, That up to \$5,000,000 of the amounts provided
15 under this heading in this Act may be used for capacity
16 building, technical assistance, and necessary costs of ad-
17 ministering funds under the heading “Community Devel-
18 opment Fund” in this Act or any prior or future Act that
19 makes amounts available for purposes related to major
20 disasters under such heading: *Provided further*, That, after
21 funds are allocated to the most impacted and distressed
22 areas resulting from major disasters in 2020 and 2021,
23 remaining amounts may be used for 2022 disasters under
24 such same authority and conditions: *Provided further*,
25 That such amount is designated by the Congress as being

1 for an emergency requirement pursuant to section
2 4001(a)(1) and section 4001(b) of S. Con. Res. 14 (117th
3 Congress), the concurrent resolution on the budget for fis-
4 cal year 2022.

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
