A BILL

To prohibit Amnesty International and its employees from receiving financial assistance from the United States Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INELIGIBILITY OF AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL**
4 **AND ITS EMPLOYEES FOR FEDERAL ASSIST-**
5 **ANCE.**

6 (a) AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL.—Notwithstanding
7 any other provision of law, Amnesty International is ineli-
8 gible to receive any money or assets from the United
9 States Government.

1 (b) EMPLOYEES OF AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL.—
2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any employee
3 of Amnesty International is ineligible to receive any direct
4 financial benefit from the United States Government.

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
