A BILL

To require an annual budget estimate for the initiatives of the National Institutes of Health pursuant to reports and recommendations made under the National Alzheimer’s Project Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Alzheimer’s Account-
5 bility and Investment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROJECT.**

2 Section 2 of the National Alzheimer’s Project Act (42
3 U.S.C. 11225) is amended—

4 (1) by redesignating subsection (h) as sub-
5 section (i); and

6 (2) by inserting after subsection (g) the fol-
7 lowing:

8 “(h) PROFESSIONAL JUDGMENT BUDGET.—For fis-
9 cal year 2024 and each subsequent fiscal year, the Direc-
10 tor of the National Institutes of Health shall prepare and
11 submit, directly to the President for review and trans-
12 mittal to Congress, an annual budget estimate for the ini-
13 tiatives of the National Institutes of Health pursuant to
14 the reports and recommendations made under this Act,
15 including an estimate of the number and type of personnel
16 needs for the National Institutes of Health.”.

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
