A BILL

To amend the Inspector General Act of 1978 relative to
the powers of the Department of Justice Inspector General.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Inspector General Ac-
5 cess Act of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. INVESTIGATIONS OF DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE**
7 **PERSONNEL.**

8 Section 8E of the Inspector General Act of 1978 (5
9 U.S.C. App.) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (b)—

2 (A) in paragraph (2), by striking “and
3 paragraph (3)”;

4 (B) by striking paragraph (3);

5 (C) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and
6 (5) as paragraphs (3) and (4), respectively; and

7 (D) in paragraph (4), as redesignated, by
8 striking “paragraph (4)” and inserting “para-
9 graph (3)”;

10 (2) in subsection (d), by striking “, except with
11 respect to allegations described in subsection
12 (b)(3),”.

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
