A BILL

To require commissary and exchange stores in the United States that offer gasoline for commercial sale to offer the sale of at least one fuel that contains not less than 13 percent ethanol.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Armed Forces Fuel
5 Choice Act of 2022”.

1 **SEC. 2. FUEL CHOICE AT COMMISSARY AND EXCHANGE**
2 **STORES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided by subsection
4 (b), each commissary or exchange store located on a mili-
5 tary installation in the United States or any territory or
6 possession of the United States that offers gasoline for
7 commercial sale shall offer the sale of at least one fuel
8 that contains not less than 13 percent ethanol not later
9 than January 1, 2024.

10 (b) EXCEPTION FOR GAS STATIONS REQUIRING NEW
11 STORAGE TANKS.—A commissary or exchange store de-
12 scribed in subsection (a) that requires the replacement of
13 an underground storage tank to offer for sale fuel de-
14 scribed in that subsection shall offer the sale of at least
15 one such fuel not later than January 1, 2025.

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
