A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to repeal the copayment requirement for recipients of Department of Veterans Affairs payments or allowances for beneficiary travel, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF COPAYMENT REQUIREMENT FOR**
4 **RECIPIENTS OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS**
5 **AFFAIRS PAYMENTS OR ALLOWANCES FOR**
6 **BENEFICIARY TRAVEL.**

7 Section 111 of title 38, United States Code, is
8 amended—

- 1 (1) by striking subsection (c);
- 2 (2) by redesignating subsections (d) through (g)
- 3 as subsections (c) through (f), respectively; and
- 4 (3) in subsection (b)(1), in the matter before
- 5 subparagraph (A), by striking “Except as provided
- 6 in subsection (c) of this section and notwithstanding
- 7 subsection (g)(2) of this section” and inserting
- 8 “Notwithstanding subsection (f)(2)”.

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
