A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Air Force to include the Modular Airborne Fire Fighting System mission as part of the basing criteria of the Air Force for C-130J aircraft for the Air National Guard.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Modernizing Aerial
5 Fire Fighting Support (MAFFS) for the National Guard
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO INCLUDE THE MODULAR AIR-**
2 **BORNE FIRE FIGHTING SYSTEM MISSION AS**
3 **PART OF THE BASING CRITERIA FOR C-130J**
4 **AIRCRAFT FOR THE AIR NATIONAL GUARD.**

5 The Secretary of the Air Force shall include the Mod-
6 ular Airborne Fire Fighting System (MAFFS) mission as
7 part of the basing criteria of the Air Force for C-130J
8 aircraft for the Air National Guard.

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
