A BILL

To amend Public Law 117–169 to prohibit the Environmental Protection Agency from using funds for methane monitoring to be used to monitor emissions of methane from livestock, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. METHANE MONITORING.**

4 Section 60105(e) of Public Law 117–169 is amend-
5 ed—

6 (1) by striking “In addition to” and inserting
7 the following:

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—In addition to”; and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(2) PROHIBITION.—Amounts made available
3 under paragraph (1) may not be used to monitor
4 emissions of methane from livestock.”.

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
