A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to provide a uniform 8-digit subheading number for all whiskies.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. UNIFORM DUTY TREATMENT OF WHISKIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 22 of the Harmonized
5 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by strik-
6 ing subheading 2208.30 and inserting the following, with
7 the article description for subheading 2208.30.00 having
8 the same degree of indentation as the article description
9 for subheading 2208.50.00:

“	2208.30.00 Whiskies	Free			\$2.04/pf liter	”.
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1 (b) INSTRUCTION TO UNITED STATES INTER-
 2 NATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION.—The United States
 3 International Trade Commission shall add statistical suf-
 4 fixes to subheading 2208.30.00 of the Harmonized Tariff
 5 Schedule of the United States, as amended by subsection
 6 (a), as follows:

2208.30.0010		Irish or Scotch in containers each holding not over 4 liters
2208.30.0015		Irish or Scotch in containers each holding over 4 liters
2208.30.0020		Bourbon in containers each holding not over 4 liters
2208.30.0025		Bourbon in containers each holding over 4 liters
2208.30.0030		Rye in containers each holding not over 4 liters
2208.30.0035		Rye in containers each holding over 4 liters
2208.30.0040		Other in containers each holding not over 4 liters
2208.30.0045		Other in containers each holding over 4 liters.

7 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 8 this section shall apply with respect to articles entered,
 9 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 10 the date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment
 11 of this Act.

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
