AN ACT

To amend the Grand Ronde Reservation Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. GRAND RONDE RESERVATION ACT AMEND-**
2 **MENT.**

3 Section 1(d) of Public Law 100–425 (commonly
4 known as the “Grand Ronde Reservation Act”) (102 Stat.
5 1594) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “lands within
7 the State of Oregon” and inserting “the 84 acres
8 known as the Thompson Strip”;

9 (2) by redesignating paragraph (2) as para-
10 graph (3); and

11 (3) by inserting after paragraph (1) the fol-
12 lowing:

13 “(2) GAMING PROHIBITION.—Any real property
14 obtained by the Tribes as part of a land claim settle-
15 ment approved by the United States shall not be eli-
16 gible, or used, for any class II gaming or class III
17 gaming under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act
18 (25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.) (as those terms are defined
19 in section 4 of that Act (25 U.S.C. 2703)).”.

20 **SEC. 2. TREATY RIGHTS OF FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED**
21 **TRIBES.**

22 Nothing in this Act, or an amendment made by this
23 Act, shall be construed to enlarge, confirm, adjudicate, af-
24 fect, or modify any treaty right of an Indian Tribe (as

- 1 defined in section 4 of the Indian Self-Determination and
- 2 Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5304)).
