Mr. PAUL introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Egypt of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Egypt is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 20–81,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
10 Record on February 16, 2021: up to one hundred

1 sixty-eight (168) RIM-116C Rolling Airframe Mis-
2 siles (RAM) Block 2 tactical missiles; RAM Guided
3 Missile Round Pack Tri-Pack shipping and storage
4 containers; operator manuals and technical docu-
5 mentation; U.S. Government and contractor engi-
6 neering, technical and logistics support services; and
7 other related elements of logistical and program sup-
8 port.

9 (2) The sale of the following defense articles
10 and services, described in Transmittal No. 21-0M,
11 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
12 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
13 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
14 Record on May 26, 2022:

15 (A) The following Major Defense Equip-
16 ment (MDE): four (4) MK 49 MOD 5 RAM
17 Guided Missile Launching Systems (GMLS)
18 (MDE).

19 (B) The following non-MOE: support
20 equipment; sparing; U.S. Government and con-
21 tractor technical assistance; and U.S. Govern-
22 ment non-technical support.

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
