Mr. CASTRO of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To require a report on former Federal employees advising foreign governments.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transparency in
5 Former Federal Employees Advising Foreign Govern-
6 ments Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON FORMER FEDERAL EMPLOYEES ADVIS-**
8 **ING FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
10 date of the enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter

1 for 3 years, the Secretary shall submit to the appropriate
2 congressional committees, the Select Committee on Intel-
3 ligence, the Committee on Homeland Security and Govern-
4 mental Affairs, and the Committee on Armed Services of
5 the Senate, and the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
6 ligence, the Committee on Oversight and Accountability,
7 and the Committee on Armed Services of the House of
8 Representatives a report that identifies former United
9 States Government senior officials who have been ap-
10 proved by the Secretary to advise foreign governments.

11 (b) FORM.—The report required under subsection (a)
12 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
13 a classified annex.

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
