A BILL

To amend the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to reduce the fiscal year 2025 discretionary spending limit for revised nonsecurity category, to rescind funds appropriated for the Department of Commerce Nonrecurring Expenses Fund, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Disaster Offset and
3 Government Efficiency Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. REVISION OF FISCAL YEAR 2025 DISCRETIONARY**
5 **SPENDING LIMIT FOR REVISED NONSECU-**
6 **RITY CATEGORY.**

7 Section 251 of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
8 Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 901(c)(10)(B)) is
9 amended—

10 (1) in subsection (c)(10)(B), by striking the
11 dollar amount and inserting “\$597,000,000,000”;
12 and

13 (2) in subsection (e)(1)—

14 (A) by striking “, as follows:” and insert-
15 ing “for the revised security category, the
16 amount calculated for such category in section
17 (d)(1)(A).”; and

18 (B) by striking subparagraphs (A) and
19 (B).

20 **SEC. 3. RESCISSION OF AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED FOR DE-**
21 **PARTMENT OF COMMERCE NONRECURRING**
22 **EXPENSES FUND.**

23 (a) RESCISSION.—The total amount of unobligated
24 funds made available by section 101(e) of the Fiscal Re-
25 sponsibility Act of 2023 (Public Law 118–5) for the De-

1 partment of Commerce Nonrecurring Expenses Fund are
2 hereby permanently rescinded.

3 (b) CLASSIFICATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.—

4 The budgetary effects of subsection (a) shall not count for
5 purposes of section 251 of the Balanced Budget and
6 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 or allocation pur-
7 suant to section 302(a) or 302(b) of the Congressional
8 Budget Act of 1974.

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
