To amend the Safe Drinking Water Act to provide grants under the Drinking Water Infrastructure Risk and Resilience Program for training programs relating to protecting public water systems from and responding to cyberattacks, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Water Cybersecurity
5 Enhancement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM RISK AND RESIL-**
2 **IENCE.**

3 (a) USE OF FUNDS.—Section 1433(g)(2)(F) of the
4 Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. 300i–2(g)(2)(F)) is
5 amended to read as follows:

6 “(F) participation in training programs,
7 and the purchase of training manuals and guid-
8 ance materials, relating to security and resil-
9 ience, including—

10 “(i) protecting public water systems
11 from cyberattacks; and

12 “(ii) responding to cyberattacks.”.

13 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
14 1433(g)(6) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C.
15 300i–2(g)(6)) is amended by striking “and 2021” and in-
16 serting “through 2030”.

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
