Mr. GOOD of Virginia (for himself, Mr. NORMAN, and Mr. PERRY) introduced
the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To prohibit contributions to the United Nations Green
Climate Fund, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Taxpayer Funding
5 for United Nations Green Climate Fund Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
8 sion of law, the Secretary of State—

9 (1) shall withhold from mandatory United
10 States contributions to the United Nations, in each

1 fiscal year, an amount that represents the same pro-
2 portion to the total United States contribution to the
3 United Nations as the proportion of the United Na-
4 tions budget for such fiscal year that will be made
5 available to the United Nations Green Climate fund
6 in that fiscal year; and

7 (2) may not make any voluntary contribution to
8 the United Nations Green Climate Fund.

9 (b) **AUTOMATIC RESCISSION.**—Amounts withheld
10 from contributions pursuant to the prohibition under sub-
11 section (a)—

12 (1) shall, on the date on which the balance of
13 such United States contribution to the United Na-
14 tions is made, be rescinded; and

15 (2) may not be considered, on or after such
16 date, to be arrears to be repaid to the United Na-
17 tions or to any entity of the United Nations.

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
