A BILL

To require the installation of security cameras at facilities of the United States Postal Service, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Postal Facilities Secu-
5 rity Camera Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. POSTAL FACILITIES SECURITY CAMERAS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to the availability of ap-
8 propriations, the United States Postal Service shall install
9 security cameras at each facility of the United States
10 Postal Service to ensure, to the extent practicable, the se-

1 curity of the employees, customers, and property of the
2 Postal Service at each such facility.

3 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
4 are authorized to be appropriated from the general fund
5 of the Treasury, to be deposited into the Postal Service
6 Fund established under section 2003 of title 39, United
7 States Code, such sums as are necessary to carry out this
8 Act.

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
