2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE AND TRASH-**
4 **FREE WATERS GRANTS.**

5 *Section 302 of the Save Our Seas 2.0 Act (33 U.S.C.*
6 *4282) is amended—*

7 *(1) in subsection (c)(1)—*

8 *(A) by inserting “States,” before “munici-*
9 *palities”; and*

10 *(B) by inserting a comma before “or Indian*
11 *Tribes”; and*

12 *(2) in subsection (d)(1), by inserting “States,”*
13 *before “units of local government”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to amend the
Save Our Seas 2.0 Act to expand eligibility for certain
wastewater infrastructure grants, and for other pur-
poses.”.
