A BILL

To apply the requirements of the Federal Vacancies Reform Act of 1998 to a vacancy in the office of the Secretary of Labor, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Department of Labor*
5 *Succession Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. APPLYING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE VACANCIES**

7 **ACT TO VACANCY IN OFFICE OF SECRETARY**
8 **OF LABOR.**

9 *The first section of the Act of April 17, 1946 (60 Stat.*
10 *91; 29 U.S.C. 552) is amended by striking the second and*
11 *third sentences and inserting the following: “The Deputy*
12 *Secretary is authorized to exercise the functions and per-*
13 *form the duties of the first assistant of the Secretary of*
14 *Labor within the meaning of section 3345 of title 5, United*
15 *States Code, and shall perform such other duties as may*
16 *be required by law or prescribed by the Secretary of*
17 *Labor.”.*

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
