A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to encourage programs to address college athlete mental health.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Targeting Emotional
5 and Mental Stability Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. COLLEGE ATHLETE MENTAL HEALTH.**

7 Section 520E–2 of the Public Health Service Act (42
8 U.S.C. 290bb–36b) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (b), by adding at the end the
2 following:

3 “(13) Carrying out one or more school-based
4 programs to address mental health disorders among
5 the college athlete population, including providing
6 access to—

7 “(A) mental health care services for college
8 athletes, including real-time counseling and
9 telehealth services;

10 “(B) peer-to-peer counseling;

11 “(C) existing crisis lifeline services, includ-
12 ing the 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline;

13 “(D) training for students, faculty, athletic
14 coaches, and staff to respond effectively to stu-
15 dents exhibiting signs of mental distress or sub-
16 stance use disorder; or

17 “(E) campus-wide education initiatives to
18 address the stigma associated with mental
19 health issues among college athletes.”; and

20 (2) in subsection (d), by adding at the end the
21 following:

22 “(9) For an institution of higher education pro-
23 posing to use the grant for an activity described in
24 paragraph (13) of subsection (b), a letter of support

- 1 from the athletics department of the institution of
- 2 higher education.”.
