## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to issue certain regulations with respect to the minimum age of a driver of a commercial motor vehicle, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reciprocity Efficiency  
5 and Age Limitation Trucking Act” or the “REAL Truck-  
6 ing Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AGE REQUIREMENT FOR COMMERCIAL MOTOR VE-**  
2 **HICLE OPERATOR.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 180 days after the  
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-  
5 tation shall issue such regulations as are necessary to up-  
6 date sections 383.5 and 390.5T of title 49, United States  
7 Code, to reduce the minimum age for an operator of a  
8 commercial motor vehicle from 21 years of age to 18 years  
9 of age.

10 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Section 23022 of  
11 the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (49 U.S.C.  
12 31315 note) is repealed.
