A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preserving JROTC
5 Programs Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION TO MINIMUM NUMBER OF PARTICI-**
2 **PATING STUDENTS REQUIRED TO ESTABLISH**
3 **OR MAINTAIN A UNIT OF JROTC.**

4 Section 2031(b)(1)(A) of title 10, United States
5 Code, is amended by striking “100” and inserting “50”.

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
