A BILL

To reauthorize the Radiation Exposure Compensation Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “RECA Extension Act
5 of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE RADIATION EXPOSURE**
7 **COMPENSATION ACT.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3(d) of the Radiation Ex-
9 posure Compensation Act (Public Law 101–426; 42
10 U.S.C. 2210 note) is amended by striking the first sen-
11 tence and inserting “The Fund shall terminate on the date

1 that is 2 years after the date of enactment of the RECA
2 Extension Act of 2024.”.

3 (b) LIMITATION ON CLAIMS.—Section 8(a) of the Ra-
4 diation Exposure Compensation Act (Public Law 101–
5 426; 42 U.S.C. 2210 note) is amended by striking “the
6 RECA Extension Act of 2022” and inserting “the RECA
7 Extension Act of 2024”.

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
