A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to require penalties for small business concerns falsely claiming goods or services are Made in America, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Made in America In-
5 tegrity Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. PENALTIES FOR SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS**
2 **FALSELY CLAIMING GOODS OR SERVICES**
3 **ARE MADE IN AMERICA.**

4 Section 16 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 645)
5 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

7 “(h) FALSE CLAIMS OF MADE IN AMERICA.—In ad-
8 dition to any other applicable penalties, a small business
9 concern that is awarded a Federal contract in part or in
10 whole because the concern falsely claims the goods or serv-
11 ices that are the subject of the contract are made or pro-
12 duced in the United States shall be subject to the penalties
13 and remedies described in subsection (d)(2), except that
14 subparagraph (D) of such subsection shall be applied to
15 such concern by substituting ‘5 years’ for ‘3 years’.”.

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
