A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Army to provide a briefing to Congress on the efforts of the Army to field passive multi-static radar detection technology for mobile counter-UAS systems, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BRIEFING ON PASSIVE MULTI-STATIC RADAR**
4 **DETECTION EFFORTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than February 1, 2025,
6 the Secretary of the Army shall provide to the Committees
7 on Armed Services of the Senate and the House of Rep-
8 resentatives a briefing on the efforts of the Army to field

1 passive multi-static radar detection technology for mobile
2 counter-UAS systems.

3 (b) ELEMENTS.—The briefing under subsection (a)
4 shall address—

5 (1) the plan of the Army to incorporate passive
6 multi-static radar technology into its existing
7 counter-UAS system and base defense architecture;

8 (2) efforts within the Army to integrate passive
9 multi-static radar technology into integrated
10 counter-UAS systems;

11 (3) an assessment of any capability gaps in
12 threat detection technology and threat defeat sys-
13 tems; and

14 (4) any research, development, test, and evalua-
15 tion activities that are being conducted, or that are
16 planned to be conducted, with respect to passive
17 multi-static radar detection.

18 (c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “counter-
19 UAS system” has the meaning given that term in section
20 44801 of title 49, United States Code.

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
