1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SILVER SEA BREAM AS ACCEPTABLE MARKET**

4 **NAME.**

5 A food shall not be treated as misbranded, adulter-
6 ated, or otherwise in violation of the Federal Food, Drug,
7 and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 301 et seq.) because the food
8 is labeled or marketed using the name “Silver Sea Bream”
9 for the species Stenotomus chrysops.
