Mr. COHEN submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2708) to prohibit discrimination against individuals with disabilities who need long-term services and supports, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 2708) to prohibit discrimina-
4 tion against individuals with disabilities who need long-
5 term services and supports, and for other purposes. All
6 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
7 The bill shall be considered as read. All points of order
8 against provisions in the bill are waived. The previous

1 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on
2 any amendment thereto to final passage without inter-
3 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
4 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
5 member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce or
6 their respective designees; and (2) one motion to recom-
7 mit.

8 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
9 the consideration of H.R. 2708.

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
