Ms. NORTON submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House of Representatives to complete a medical emergency preparedness training, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. MANDATORY MEDICAL EMERGENCY PRE-**
3 **PAREDNESS TRAINING.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Rule XXIX of the Rules of the
5 House of Representatives is amended by adding at the end
6 the following:

1 “5.(a) Each Member, Delegate, Resident Commis-
2 sioner, officer, and employee of the House of Representa-
3 tives shall complete a medical emergency preparedness
4 training offered by the Office of the Attending Physician,
5 which shall include training in—

6 “(1) cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and

7 “(2) the use of an automated external
8 defibrillator.

9 “(b)(1) Each Member, Delegate, Resident Commis-
10 sioner, officer, and employee of the House shall complete
11 the training under this clause not later than 90 days after
12 beginning service to the House, and annually thereafter.

13 “(2) The Office of the Attending Physician shall pro-
14 vide certification of the completion of the training estab-
15 lished by this paragraph.”.

16 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

17 (1) IN GENERAL.—This resolution and the
18 amendments made by this resolution shall take ef-
19 fect on the date that is 90 days after the date of the
20 adoption of this resolution.

21 (2) TRAINING DEADLINE FOR CURRENT CON-
22 GRESS.—Not later than 90 days after the effective
23 date specified in paragraph (1), an individual who is
24 serving as a Member, Delegate, Resident Commis-
25 sioner, officer, or employee of the House of Rep-

1 representatives as of such effective date shall complete
2 the medical emergency preparedness training re-
3 quired under clause 5(a) of Rule XXIX of the Rules
4 of the House of Representatives, as added by this
5 resolution.
