A BILL

To amend the permitting requirements of foreign air carriers,
and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fair and Open Skies
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PERMIT REQUIREMENTS OF FOREIGN AIR CAR-**
7 **RIERS.**

8 (a) PUBLIC INTEREST TEST.—Section 41302(2) of
9 title 49, United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “under an
2 agreement with the United States Government; or”
3 and inserting “; and”; and

4 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking “the for-
5 eign air transportation” and inserting “after consid-
6 ering the totality of the circumstances, including the
7 factors set forth in section 40101(a), the foreign air
8 transportation”.

9 (b) PUBLIC INTEREST REQUIREMENTS.—

10 (1) POLICY.—Section 40101(a) of title 49,
11 United States Code, is amended by adding at the
12 end the following:

13 “(17) preventing the undermining of labor
14 standards.”.

15 (2) INTERNATIONAL AIR TRANSPORTATION.—
16 Section 40101(e) of title 49, United States Code, is
17 amended by adding at the end the following:

18 “(11) preventing the undermining of labor
19 standards.”.
