Mr. CRUZ (for himself and Mr. RUBIO) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To prohibit agencies from using the term “Latinx” in official communications or forms.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Respect for Hispanic
5 Americans Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF “LATINX”.**

7 (a) AGENCY DEFINED.—In this section, the term
8 “agency” has the meaning given the term in section 551
9 of title 5, United States Code.

1 (b) PROHIBITION.—The head of an agency and any
2 employee of the agency may not use the term “Latinx”
3 in any official communication or form of the agency.
