Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To require reporting on sexual assault in surveys.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARMED FORCES SURVEYS.**

4 Section 481(c) of title 10, United States Code,
5 is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (3), (4), and
7 (5) as paragraphs (4), (5), and (6), respectively; and

8 (2) by inserting after paragraph (2) the fol-
9 lowing new paragraph:

10 “(3) Indicators of the assault (including un-
11 wanted sexual contact) that give reason to believe
12 that the victim was targeted, or discriminated

1 against, or both, for their real or perceived sexual
2 orientation or status in a group as described under
3 subsections (b) or (c), and any other factor consid-
4 ered appropriate by the Secretary.”.

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
