Mr. DAINES introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To make aliens who are holders of a passport issued by the Palestinian Authority ineligible for visas, admission, or parole into the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLES.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Guaranteeing Aggres-
5 sors Zero Admission Act” or the “GAZA Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INELIGIBILITY FOR VISAS, ADMISSION, OR PAROLE.**

7 An alien who is holder of a passport issued by the
8 Palestinian Authority—

9 (1) is inadmissible to the United States;

1 (2) is ineligible to receive a visa or other docu-
2 mentation to enter the United States; and

3 (3) is otherwise ineligible to be admitted or pa-
4 roled into the United States or to receive any other
5 benefit under the Immigration and Nationality Act
6 (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.).

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
