A BILL

To provide for a permanent extension and expansion of the pilot program for streamlining awards for innovative technology projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defense Innovation
5 and Small Business Momentum Act of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT EXTENSION AND EXPANSION OF PILOT**
7 **PROGRAM FOR STREAMLINING AWARDS FOR**
8 **INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS.**

9 (a) EXCEPTIONS TO COST OR PRICING DATA RE-
10 QUIREMENTS.—Section 3703 of title 10, United States

1 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
2 subsection:

3 “(g) PROGRAM FOR STREAMLINING AWARDS FOR
4 SMALL BUSINESSES AND NONTRADITIONAL DEFENSE
5 CONTRACTORS.—The requirements under section 3702(a)
6 of this title shall not apply to any contract, subcontract,
7 or modification of a contract or subcontract valued at less
8 than \$7,500,000 awarded to a small business concern (as
9 that term is defined in section 3 of the Small Business
10 Act (15 U.S.C. 632) or nontraditional defense con-
11 tractor.”.

12 (b) REVISIONS TO DFARS.—The Secretary of De-
13 fense shall amend the Defense Federal Acquisition Regu-
14 lation Supplement (DFARS) to implement the program
15 established under subsection (g) of section 3703 of title
16 10, United States Code, as added by subsection (a), ensur-
17 ing the application of the program to all small business
18 concerns and streamlining the awards process for innova-
19 tive technology projects.

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
