A BILL

To require the United States Postal Service to implement recommendations from the Inspector General of the United States Postal Service for decreasing instances of delayed mail and improving staffing and training, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rural Mail Delivery
5 Improvement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR THE POSTAL SERVICE TO IM-**
2 **PLEMENT CERTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS OF**
3 **THE INSPECTOR GENERAL.**

4 Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment
5 of this Act, the United States Postal Service shall review
6 and, to the extent practicable, implement the rec-
7 ommendations of the Inspector General of the United
8 States Postal Service with respect to delayed mail, staff-
9 ing, and training in the report by the Office of the Inspec-
10 tor General of the United States Postal Service entitled
11 “Delivery in Northern Minnesota: Audit Report” (24–
12 048–R24), dated May 6, 2024.

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
