To amend the Granger-Thye Act to modify the maximum term for certain special use permits for housing.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FOREST SERVICE SPECIAL USE PERMITS FOR**
4 **HOUSING.**

5 Section 7 of the Act of April 24, 1950 (commonly
6 known as the “Granger-Thye Act”) (64 Stat. 84, chapter
7 97; 16 U.S.C. 580d), is amended by striking “thirty years
8 as determined by him” and inserting “30 years, or in the
9 case of a permit for housing that is located west of the

- 1 100th meridian in the contiguous 48 States, 100 years,
- 2 as determined by the Secretary of Agriculture”.
