AN ACT

To designate the America's National Churchill Museum National Historic Landmark, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "America's National
- 3 Churchill Museum National Historic Landmark Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 5 In this Act:
- 6 (1) CITY.—The term "City" means the city of
- 7 Fulton, Missouri.
- 8 (2) College.—The term "College" means
- 9 Westminster College, located at 501 Westminster
- 10 Avenue in the City.
- 11 (3) LANDMARK.—The term "Landmark" means
- the America's National Churchill Museum National
- Historic Landmark designated by section 3(a).
- 14 (4) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
- the Secretary of the Interior.
- 16 (5) STATE.—The term "State" means the State
- of Missouri.
- 18 SEC. 3. AMERICA'S NATIONAL CHURCHILL MUSEUM NA-
- 19 TIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARK.
- 20 (a) Designation.—America's National Churchill
- 21 Museum located at the College, including the Winston
- 22 Churchill Memorial listed on the National Register of His-
- 23 toric Places, is designated as the "America's National
- 24 Churchill Museum National Historic Landmark".
- 25 (b) Cooperative Agreements.—

1	(1) In General.—The Secretary, in consulta-
2	tion with the State, the City, and the College, may
3	enter into cooperative agreements with appropriate
4	public or private entities, for the purposes of—
5	(A) protecting historic resources at the
6	Landmark; and
7	(B) providing educational and interpretive
8	facilities and programs at the Landmark for the
9	public.
10	(2) TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.—
11	The Secretary may provide technical and financial
12	assistance to any entity with which the Secretary
13	has entered into a cooperative agreement under
14	paragraph (1).
15	(c) No Effect on Actions of Property Own-
16	ERS.—Designation of the America's National Churchill
17	Museum as a National Historic Landmark shall not pro-
18	hibit any actions that may otherwise be taken by a prop-
19	erty owner (including the College and any other owner of
20	the Landmark) with respect to the property of the owner.
21	(d) No Effect on Administration.—Nothing in
22	this section affects the administration of the Landmark
23	by the State, the City, or the College.

1 SEC. 4. SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY.

2	(a) In General.—The Secretary shall conduct a
3	special resource study of the Landmark.
4	(b) Contents.—In conducting the study under this
5	section, the Secretary shall—
6	(1) evaluate the national significance of the
7	Landmark;
8	(2) determine the suitability and feasibility of
9	designating the Landmark as a unit of the National
10	Park System;
11	(3)(A) consider alternatives to that designation
12	for the preservation, protection, and interpretation
13	of the Landmark by the Federal Government, the
14	State, the City and other affected units of local gov-
15	ernment, or private and nonprofit organizations (in-
16	cluding the College); and
17	(B) identify cost estimates for any Federal ac-
18	quisition, development, interpretation, operation, and
19	maintenance associated with the alternatives de-
20	scribed in subparagraph (A); and
21	(4) consult with interested Federal agencies,
22	the State, the City and other affected units of local
23	government, private and nonprofit entities (including
24	the College), and other interested individuals.

- 1 (c) REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary shall conduct the
- 2 study under this section in accordance with section
- 3 100507 of title 54, United States Code.
- 4 (d) Report.—Not later than 3 years after the date
- 5 on which funds are first made available to carry out the
- 6 study under this section, the Secretary shall submit to the
- 7 Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the Sen-
- 8 ate and the Committee on Natural Resources of the House
- 9 of Representatives a report that describes—
- 10 (1) the results of the study; and
- 11 (2) any conclusions and recommendations of the
- 12 Secretary.
