Mr. CRUZ (for himself and Mr. CORNYN) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To terminate the obligation to repay bonuses of former mem-
bers of the Armed Forces separated for refusing the
COVID–19 vaccine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF OBLIGATION TO REPAY BO-**
4 **NUSES OF MEMBERS SEPARATED FOR RE-**
5 **FUSING COVID–19 VACCINE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—A former member of the Armed
7 Forces who was separated from the Armed Forces because
8 the former member refused to obtain a COVID–19 vaccine
9 shall be released for any obligation to repay any bonus
10 received by the former member.

1 (b) REIMBURSEMENT OF REPAYMENTS.—A former
2 member of the Armed Forces described in subsection (a)
3 who, before the date of the enactment of this Act, repaid
4 any portion of a bonus described in that subsection shall
5 be reimbursed for such repayment.

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
