1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Lieutenant Osvaldo
- 3 Albarati Stopping Prison Contraband Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. PROHIBITED PROVISION OF A PHONE.
- 5 Section 1791(b) of title 18, United States Code, is
- 6 amended—
- 7 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as
- 8 paragraphs (5) and (6), respectively;
- 9 (2) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
- 10 lowing:
- 11 "(4) in the case of a violation of subsection
- 12 (a)(1), imprisonment for not more than 2 years, or
- both, if the object is specified in subsection
- (d)(1)(F) of this section;"; and
- 15 (3) in paragraph (5), as so redesignated, by in-
- serting ", in the case of a violation of subsection
- 17 (a)(2)," before "(d)(1)(F)".
- 18 SEC. 3. REVIEW OF POLICIES.
- Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
- 20 of this Act, the Director of the Bureau of Prisons shall—
- 21 (1) conduct a review of the policies of the Bu-
- reau of Prisons pertaining to immates who make,
- possess, obtain, or attempt to make or obtain a pro-
- hibited object, as defined in section 1791(d)(1) of
- 25 title 18, United States Code; and

- 1 (2) update those policies as needed to improve
- 2 protections for incarcerated individuals and staff.
