**A BILL**

To establish the Chiricahua National Park in the State of Arizona as a unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Chiricahua National  
5       Park Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF CHIRICAHUA NATIONAL PARK,**  
2 **ARIZONA.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Chiricahua National  
5 Monument in the State of Arizona established by  
6 Presidential Proclamation 1692 (54 U.S.C. 320301  
7 note; 43 Stat. 1946) shall be known and designated  
8 as “Chiricahua National Park” (referred to in this  
9 Act as the “National Park”).

10 (2) BOUNDARIES.—The boundaries of the Na-  
11 tional Park shall be the boundaries of the Chiri-  
12 cahua National Monument as of the date of enact-  
13 ment of this Act, as generally depicted on the map  
14 entitled “Chiricahua National Park Proposed  
15 Boundary”, numbered 145/156,356, and dated  
16 March 2021.

17 (3) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law,  
18 map, regulation, document, or other record of the  
19 United States to the Chiricahua National Monument  
20 shall be considered to be a reference to the “Chiri-  
21 cahua National Park”.

22 (4) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Any funds avail-  
23 able for the Chiricahua National Monument shall be  
24 available for the National Park.

25 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—The Secretary of the Interior  
26 shall administer the National Park in accordance with—

1           (1) Presidential Proclamation 1692 (54 U.S.C.  
2       320301 note; 43 Stat. 1946);

3           (2) Presidential Proclamation 2288 (54 U.S.C.  
4       320301 note; 52 Stat. 1551); and

5           (3) the laws generally applicable to units of the  
6       National Park System, including—

7           (A) section 100101(a), chapter 1003, and  
8       sections 100751(a), 100752, 100753, and  
9       102101 of title 54, United States Code; and

10          (B) chapter 3201 of title 54, United States  
11       Code.
