RESOLUTION

Congratulating the Fighting Irish of the University of Notre Dame men's lacrosse team for winning the 2024 National Collegiate Athletic Association Division I Men's Lacrosse National Championship.

Whereas, on May 27, 2024, the University of Notre Dame Men's Lacrosse Team (referred to in this preamble as the "Fighting Irish") won the 2024 National Collegiate Athletic Association (referred to in this preamble as the "NCAA") Division I title with a 15 to 5 win over the Maryland Terrapins in Philadelphia;

Whereas the victory marked the second national title and a consecutive national championship for the Fighting Irish;

Whereas the Fighting Irish is the first team since 2019 and 2021 to win back-to-back men's lacrosse NCAA national

championships in consecutive seasons, and the eighth team in NCAA Division I history to accomplish the feat;

Whereas head coach Kevin Corrigan was supported by assistant coaches and staff, including Ryan Wellner, Chris Wojcik, Ryder Garnsey, Rob Simpson, Joshua Skube, Mandy Merritt, Robby Hamman, Zach Korten, Darin Ottaviani, and Ron Powlus;

3 men’s lacrosse team for its victory in the National
4 Collegiate Athletic Association (referred to in this
5 resolution as the “NCAA”) tournament, claiming
6 the 2024 NCAA Division I title; and
