A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to eliminate the use
of official time by Federal employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Union Time on
5 the Taxpayer’s Dime Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF OFFICIAL TIME.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7131 of title 5, United
8 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

1 **“§ 7131. Elimination of official time**

2 “Any activities performed by an employee relating to
3 the business of a labor organization shall be performed
4 during the time the employee is in a non-duty status.”.

5 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
6 for subchapter IV of chapter 71 of title 5, United States
7 Code, is amended by striking the item relating to section
8 7131 and inserting the following:

“7131. Elimination of official time.”.
