Mr. BIGGS of Arizona (for himself, Mr. CRANE, Mr. BRECHEEN, and Mrs. LUNA) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit Federal funds from being awarded or otherwise
made available to the Manhattan District Attorney’s Office.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Accountability for
5 Lawless Violence In our Neighborhoods Act” or the
6 “ALVIN Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING WITH RE-**
8 **SPECT TO MANHATTAN DISTRICT ATTORNEY.**

9 (a) PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING.—Notwith-
10 standing any other provision of law, no Federal funds may

1 be awarded or otherwise made available to the Manhattan
2 District Attorney's Office.

3 (b) RECISION AND REPAYMENT OF FEDERAL FUND-
4 ING.—The unobligated balances of all amounts allocated
5 for or otherwise made available to the Manhattan District
6 Attorney's Office is hereby rescinded, and the Attorney
7 General shall take such steps as may be necessary and
8 practicable to require the Manhattan District Attorney's
9 Office to reimburse the Federal Government for all
10 amounts expended for such Office after the date of Janu-
11 ary 1, 2022.

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
