A BILL

To provide that none of the funds made available to the National Endowment for the Humanities for any fiscal year may be used to carry out section 7 of the National Foundation on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defund National En-
5 dowment for the Humanities Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION.**

7 None of the funds made available to the National En-
8 dowment for the Humanities for any fiscal year may be

1 used to carry out section 7 of the National Foundation
2 on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
3 956).

4 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

5 This Act shall take effect on the 1st day of the 1st
6 fiscal year that begins after the date of the enactment of
7 this Act.

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
