A BILL

To prohibit the hiring of individuals who are not citizens of the United States to administer an election for Federal office in a State or local jurisdiction, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Foreign Persons
5 Administering Our Elections Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT TO HIRING OF**
2 **ELECTION ADMINISTRATORS FOR AN ELEC-**
3 **TION FOR FEDERAL OFFICE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—A State or local jurisdiction may
5 not hire an individual who is not a citizen of the United
6 States to administer an election for Federal office in the
7 State or local jurisdiction.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall apply with
9 respect to any election for Federal office held on or after
10 the date of the enactment of this Act.
