A BILL

To repeal certain provisions relating to taxpayer subsidies for home electrification, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Homeowner Energy
5 Freedom Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. HOMEOWNER ENERGY FREEDOM.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The following are repealed:

1 (1) Section 50122 of Public Law 117–169 (42
2 U.S.C. 18795a; 136 Stat. 2036) (commonly known
3 as the “Inflation Reduction Act”).

4 (2) Section 50123 of Public Law 117–169 (42
5 U.S.C. 1879b; 136 Stat. 2041) (commonly known as
6 the “Inflation Reduction Act”).

7 (3) Section 50131 of Public Law 117–169 (136
8 Stat. 2041) (commonly known as the “Inflation Re-
9 duction Act”).

10 (b) RESCISSIONS.—The unobligated balances of any
11 amounts made available under each of the sections de-
12 scribed in subsection (a) (as in effect on the day before
13 the date of enactment of this Act) are rescinded.

14 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
15 50121(c)(7) of Public Law 117–169 (42 U.S.C.
16 18795(c)(7); 136 Stat. 2033) (commonly known as the
17 “Inflation Reduction Act”) is amended by striking “, in-
18 cluding a rebate provided under a high-efficiency electric
19 home rebate program (as defined in section 50122(d)),”.

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
