A BILL

To strengthen trafficking victim assistance grant funding.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supporting Victims
5 of Human Trafficking Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. GRANTS TO ASSIST VICTIMS OF TRAFFICKING.**

7 Section 107(b)(2) of the Trafficking Victims Protec-
8 tion Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7105(b)(2)) is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (B)—

10 (A) in the matter preceding clause (i), by
11 striking “shall” and insert “may”;

1 (B) in clause (i), by striking “three per-
2 cent” and inserting “ up to 7 percent”;

3 (C) in clause (ii)—

4 (i) by striking “5 percent” and insert-
5 ing “up to 10 percent”; and

6 (ii) by inserting “and strengthening
7 program administration and budgeting”
8 after “activities”; and

9 (D) in clause (iii), by striking “one per-
10 cent” and inserting “up to 1 percent”; and

11 (2) in subparagraph (C), strike “75 percent”
12 and insert “95 percent”.

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
